

Transportation



Fabrications of up to 600 tonnes can be moved throughout BAE SYSTEMS Submarines site at Barrow using in-house transporters, eliminating the delays associated with using specialist transport firms.

Two 300-tonne transporters, which can be linked together, and a 100-tonne vehicle are readily available.

All transporters are licensed by the Department of Transport to use the public highway linking the Fabrication Department with the company's own docking facilities.



BAE SYSTEMS Submarines holds the record for the heaviest load moved on a British road, achieved when the complete 2832 tonne stern hull block of HMS Bulwark was transited from the shipyard's covered construction hall to the superberth in November 2000 using interlinked transporters.
