

Air Warrior

The Air Warrior system is a totally modular system that provides the aviator with advanced life support capabilities. The system increases freedom of movement at flight controls, improves mobility to safely operate aircraft systems, enables ingress and egress from the aircraft, and offers enhanced comfort and cooling while increasing mission duration time in full mission-oriented protective posture ensemble.

Major components of the Air Warrior CIE system include:

- Primary Survival Gear Carrier (PSGC)
- Flexible Body Armor (FBA)
- Over-water gear carrier
- Flotation collar
- Weapon holster
- Extension tether

Standard Features

- Flexible body armor
 - Ballistic resistance testing in accordance with MIL-STD-662
 - Protects against fragmenting munitions, handgun, and rifle threats
 - Rigid ballistic upgrade plate defeats multiple small arms and rifle rounds
 - Sizes from X-Small to X-Large
- Flotation collar provides 65 lb (29 kg) of buoyancy

Primary Survival Gear Carrier (PSGC)

The Air Warrior PSGC is used by helicopter aircrew for survival gear carriage, extraction and retrieval, and aircrew restraint. The PSGC vest consists of a back panel, left and right front panels, and leg straps. The set also includes an assortment of pouches and platforms for the carriage of mission specific gear.

Features

- One size fits all
- Interior stowed and tethered platforms for signaling and first aid equipment
- Exterior Modular Lightweight Load Carrying Equipment (MOLLE) attachment points for additional storage pockets and equipment
- Steel D-ring on shoulder for securing the Underwater Breathing Device (UBD)

- Thigh-, shoulder- or MOLLE-mounted holster
